

Accessibility Car Parks on the Cotswold Way

Here are the main car parks along the Cotswold Way (with location links to what3words) and the options available from each of them. Note: charges may apply.

Lansdown Park & Ride

Access: Excellent for buggies and mobility vehicles onto the recreation ground but then restricted by kissing gates. Not on the Cotswold Way this is the start point for the Cotswold Way Circular Walk to Bath.

Cold Ashton Village Hall

Access: On the Cotswold Way with quiet lanes but access is limited by a kissing gate beyond the church.

Wotton-under-Edge

Access: Centrally located access to north limited by steep incline but good to the south along the trail.

Stinchcombe Hill

Access: On the Cotswold Way with a loop suitable for Trampers, buggies and maybe larger mobility scooters.

Cam Peak Car Park

Access: Good to Cam Long Down for Trampers and buggies Access south on the Trail is limited by a kissing gate.

Coaley Peak

Access: On the Cotswold Way and give access for about 2km but further access is limited by kissing gates in both directions.

Haresfield Beacon

Access: To the grassy trails around Haresfield Beacon and southwards into Standish Woods. This is the car park for the <u>Haresfield Beacon – Bruce Trail Circular Walk</u>

Painswick – Ramblers Car Park

Access: Good to the north up to Painswick Common.

Coopers Hill

Access: Along lanes and tracks to the north through Witcombe Wood

Barrow Wake Viewpoint

Access: Limited as the narrow trail runs along the side of the escarpment.

Crickley Hill Country Park

Access: Excellent for mobility vehicles in both directions.

Hartley Lane Car Park

Access: Car park for the Leckhampton Accessibility Route



Seven Springs

Access: Large lay-by is right with reasonable access going north and possibly south to Leckhampton Hill.

Cleeve Hill

Access;: Good over Cleeve Hill and north towards Postlip.

Hailes Abbey

Access: Good north up to Hailes Wood and south towards Winchcombe.

Stanton

Access: Good north through the village and up the hill, and south across the fields to Stanway.

Broadway.

Access: Limited to just the village

Fish Hill Picnic Site.

Access: Limited in both directions.

Dovers Hill

Access: Good down to Chipping Campden on grassland and hard paths.
